The Dance

- A **sock hop (record hop)** is an informal dance event that will include popular music and dances of many generations. We've added a one hour dance lesson featuring simultaneous sessions by Louie Stallone & Paul Collins who'll help you recall some of the line dances, individual dances, partner dances, rock 'n' roll dances, swing dances, and mixers that you may have had fun doing long ago, or not so long ago!
- After the lesson, you'll enjoy listening and dancing to tunes from the past, present and future as your friendly disc jockey, "DJ-LUAP" will spin dance music from various eras.

The Schedule

- **8:00pm – 9:00pm – Dance Lessons – Simultaneous Lessons in Two Studios**
 - **Partner Dance Lesson with Louie Stallone**
 - One Step: Dance to the steamy hot blues music dancing to the beat of the music.
 - Rumba: Get your hips moving dancing this 4 Count dance to those Latin numbers.
 - East Coast Swing: Learn the basic 6 count swing step and some fun turns
 - **Line Dance & Mixer Lesson with Paul Collins**
 - Learn selected line dances from the 1950s to the present, including Madison Time, The Roach, Pata Pata, Pride and Joy, Cupid Shuffle, The Wobble. We may do 1 or 2 mixers in this session.

The Dance Instructors

- **Louie Stallone** has been dancing full throttle since 1985 learning to Contra, Cajun, and Swing dance as well as a post-modern dance form called Contact Improv. Since 1987, Louie has taught a variety of dance styled including Swing, Cajun/Zydeco and Ballroom. Louie teaches Old Town School of Folk Music and for the Chicago Department on Aging and with the City of Chicago's Summer Dance series.
- **Paul Collins** started dancing at the age of 8 and has been an instructor & caller since high school. Paul has called Square/Contra dances from the North Country to the Deep South and has led International Folk Dance groups at the University of Chicago, University of Illinois and Old Town School of Folk Music. He currently leads Ethnic Dance Chicago and has taught ethnic, polka, waltz and rock 'n' roll dance for Chicago SummerDance.

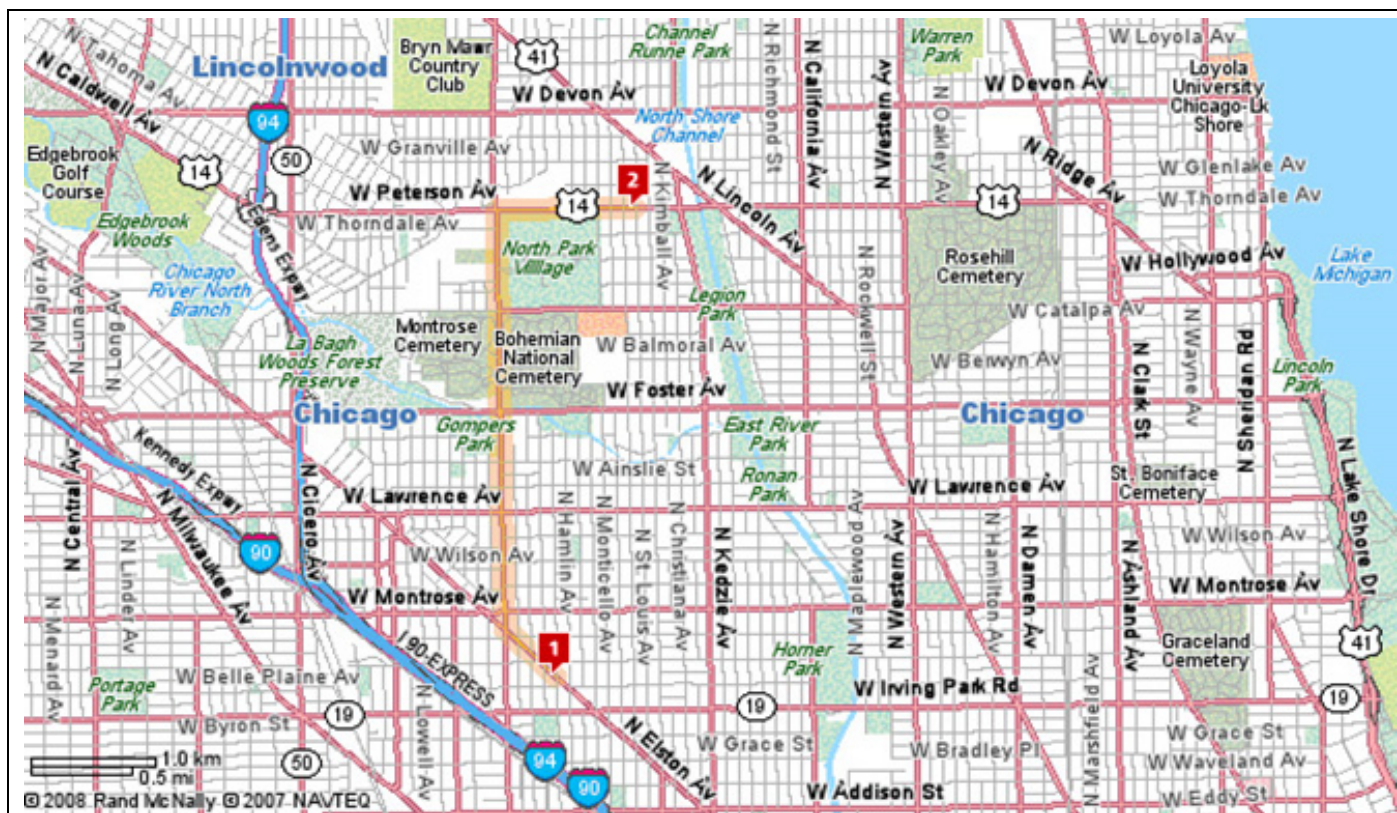
